What are the opportunities for Parent Involvement with GLO?

Visiting: We have an open door policy. Parents / Guardians are welcome to visit at any time during the course of the program day.

Daily Activities: Have an extra hour or two? Swing by the program for a participatory visit by helping out with homework time, making snacks, play kickball, or read a story. It's a great way to learn about the program in a hands-on way. Contacting the Site Director in advance is encouraged.

Program Site Council: The Site Council will help coordinate special events. The council acts as a liaison between the school and GLO. Members will advise and give feedback to the GLO Site Director about the program.

GLO Board of Directors: The GLO Board of Directors meets monthly to provide support for the Executive Director and oversees the organization's policies, finances, and strategy for the future. Candidates with expertise in Human Resources, Finance / Accounting, Law, Non-Profit Management, and Fundraising are encouraged to inquire.

Special Events: A fun way to contribute to the program is to sign up help out with Special Events throughout the school year. Parents are a critical part of the success to Health Week, Parent Night's Shows, Valentine's Day Parties, Day In The Park, Festivals and much more. Parents can help by donating time, prizes, food, or money.

Does GLO offer full-day programs on non-school days?

Yes. GLO offers full-day programs on the following non-school days at \$38/day:

October	Columbus/Indigenous People's Day/Dia de la Raza
November	Veteran's Day
December / January	Winter Recess
January	Lunar New Year (when observed by SFUSD)
March	Cesar Chavez Day
March / April	Spring Break
Varies	SFUSD Professional Development Days

Registration forms for non-school day participation will be distributed approximately 1 month before program dates. GLO traditionally only opens 1 school site for each full-day program; rotating between GLO school sites: Alvarado, Fairmount, Alice Fong Yu, West Portal, Sherman, and Dianne Feinstein campuses.

Does GLO open early during Parent / Teacher Weeks?

Yes. GLO afterschool programs will start at 12:50pm during the Fall and Spring Parent / Teacher Weeks.
